School Uniform

With the summer approaching we would like to remind everyone of the expectation around correct uniform please and that this includes the correct PE kit. We have seen a range of PE kits over the last year, so this is something that we would like to tighten up on please. Please do not send any fancy or designer clothing or shoes - simple unbranded kits of the correct colours are all that are required for school please.

School Uniform:

- Red sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan,.
- Red or white polo shirt,
- Black or grey shorts/trousers/ knee length skirt,
- Black school shoes with closed toes and minimal flat heels.

The only jewellery that is permitted at school are small simple stud earrings. Please no dangly earrings or hanging bracelets or necklaces as these are not safe in the school environment.

Make up and nail varnish should not be worn.

PE Kit:

All the children need to ensure that they have the appropriate kit in order to participate in PE. This may be indoors or outdoors.

The main PE kit is:

- Plain white t-shirt and
- Black/navy shorts.
- Plain white or black trainers for outdoors or plimsolls/sandshoes are great for inside. **(no brands/labels please)**

However, during the colder months they may also need:

- Plain black/navy hoodie.
- Plain black/navy joggers or leggings. Uniform with the school logo on is available to buy from steadyschoolwear.co.uk if preferred but plain is absolutely fine.
