Our Weekly Music Teaching Offer

Every child receives 1 hour of Music teaching a week in our school - it is a spiral, multi-sensory and well sequenced curriculum designed for Easington's needs. All pupils - attend our daily **whole-school music worship** which includes Listening and Singing.

- **EYFS pupils** - receive a 20 minute music lesson (bespoke Easington curriculum) with our Music Specialist based on traditional rhyme and song with lots of opportunities to explore instruments, sing and perform.
- **KS1 pupils** - receive a 20 min Music lesson with Music Specialist - bespoke curriculum using Jolly Music plus a range of untuned percussion plus lots of singing, composing and music games.
- **KS2 pupils** - receive a 45 min Music lesson with Music Specialist, Children explore all musical dimensions and have opportunities to play instruments including recorder, ukulele, untuned and tuned percussion, keyboard. ALL instruments played in school are used to perform as a class band. All classes do listening (using the MMC), performing, composing & singing too).

Our Music Assemblies

Delivered by Mrs Groves all of our pupils access daily 30 worship with an additional focus on 'Singing and listening'. Children listen to music from a range of genres, time periods and locations all around the world (adapted from the Model Music Curriculum). We use this as time to come together and sing. We also use the time to help our children prepare for our calendar of performances events. SEND we aim to make our provision accessible to all.



Playing instruments

All of our KS2 children have the option to choose and learn to play an instrument with specialist peripatetic teachers from East Ridings Music Service - Mrs McKee, including strings, piano/keyboard.
