The Children are invited to come to school in **non-uniform** for a suggested donation of **£1**, with all proceeds going directly to Comic Relief to help make a difference.


 We'll also be holding a bake sale at break time, with any remaining treats available to purchase at the end of the day. (Baked donations would be greatly appreciated)
